

## Defend the Honor

3 **WHEREAS**, World War II Ken Burns Documentary excluded Native Americans and  
4 Hispanics and undermined the unity of our country's effort of WWII and ignored the  
5 patriotism, sacrifices, proud and honorable dedication and contributions to our  
6 country's 500,000 Hispanic military service men and women of WWII;

7  
8 **WHEREAS**, the Hispanic community, Congressional Hispanic Caucus, Individual  
9 members of Congress, Texas and California Legislatures, National Council of the La  
10 Raza, National Hispanic Media and the American G. I. Forum an Hispanic veterans  
11 organization, chartered by Congress. Complained and condemned the omission of  
12 Hispanic Veterans. PBS response was not to interfere with Ken Burns's artistic freedom;

14 **WHEREAS**, the WWII Documentary CD its accompanying book and educational  
15 material will be part of schools' education of WWII and has omitted the true history of  
16 WWII and should be corrected;

18 **WHEREAS**, President and CEO Ms Paula Kerger Public Broadcast System and Ken  
19 Burns' Florentine Production Company finally relented and shall assemble a production  
20 team to include Hispanic contributions to WWII war effort and shall have a Hispanic  
21 producer;

23 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Washington State Democratic Central  
24 Committee applaud the efforts of the coalition named Defend the Honor that made PBS  
25 CEO Paula Kerger and Ken Burns see the light to do what is historically correct and  
26 proper and honorable for our Hispanic WWII contributions, and the Chair will send a  
27 letter to PBS and Ken Burns urging an integral Hispanic and Native American  
28 component within this documentary.
