3 **A RESOLUTION** of the Washington State Democratic Central Committee in keeping
4 with our platform and in support of proposed Constitutional amendment EHJR 4202 to
5 allow local school levies to be approved by a simple majority of the voters;
6

7 **WHEREAS**, Washington's Constitution states that it is the paramount duty of the State
8 to provide for the education of all children, and;
9

10 **WHEREAS**, adequate, stable funding is critical to the fulfillment of this mission; and
11 resources provided through voter-approved school levies are essential to local school
12 districts' ability to provide a well-rounded school levies are essential to local school
13 districts' ability to provide a well-rounded, quality education to each student; and
14

15 **WHEREAS**, local levy dollars account for a critical portion of the operating budget in
16 most districts statewide; and
17

18 **WHEREAS**, school districts are required to receive 60 percent approval for ongoing
19 levies, even though other property tax measures do not face the same requirement; and
20 EHJR 4204 would promote fairness by allowing school levies to be approved by a
21 majority of those voting, and
22

23 **WHEREAS**, EHJR 4204 will appear on the November 2007 ballot for approval by a
24 majority of Washington voters;

26 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Washington State Democratic Central
27 Committee, support EHJR 4204 which allows citizens throughout the State to support
28 students learning through simple majority approval of school levies.
