4   **WHEREAS** the most recent election cycle was one of the most successful election cycles  
5 on a national basis in many decades;

7   **WHEREAS** the 50-state initiative created numerous victories and close races in  
8 previously uncompetitive districts;

10   **WHEREAS** the success of this program has energized Democrats everywhere;

13 voter database;

15   **WHEREAS** maintenance and growth of a voter database containing pertinent  
16 information is essential to successful election strategy; and

19 future electoral success;

21   **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the state party should continue to budget for a  
22 staff level in data management adequate to maintain and grow the database throughout  
23 2009-2010 and beyond.
