Resolution Supporting the Columbia Basin Water Initiative

WHEREAS, the Columbia Basin Development League has established the water

- 5 initiative to address the issue of the water level of the Odessa Sub-Area, which is in 6 jeopardy; 7 8 WHEREAS, to supply long term support to assure more surface water will become 9 available to the Columbia Basin Project by using surface water from the Columbia River 10 to help replenish the water of the aquifers by replacing well water with surface water; 11 12 WHEREAS, the Columbia Basin Project originally authorized 1,095,000 acres using less 13 than 6 % of water from the Columbia River, currently 650,000 acres are irrigated by the 14 project; 15 16 WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 acres are irrigated from the Odessa Sub-Area 17 ground water by the use of ground water from deep wells pumping water from the 18 aquifers, causing drastically lowered water table; 19 20 WHEREAS, it would be an economic disaster for both the Columbia Basin and the State 21 of Washington if the wells would have to be shut down and no replacement was 22 devised; 23 24 WHEREAS, this would improve the environmental issues concerning the aquifers and 25 enhance recreation and wildlife in the area: 26 27 WHEREAS, Governor Christine Gregoire has allocated \$600,000 to continue the study 28 of the project as matching funds from the Federal Government; 29 30 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the only way to address the decline of the 31 Odessa Sub-Area is to make more surface water available through the Columbia Basin 32 Project to replenish this water. A large proportion of the project has already been 33 studied and engineered from the planning of the original Columbia Basin Project. 34 35 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Washington State Democratic 36 Central Committee support this important issue and request further support of the 37 Legislative (both State and Federal) action to secure appropriate funding for the 38 expansion of the Columbia Basin Project. 39 40 Submitted to the WSDCC for consideration at its January 28, 2006 meeting in South 41
