

Resolution on Internet Privacy Standards

3 **WHEREAS**, Existing privacy laws do not cover new vaults of online data such as web-
4 based email on internet servers such as Hotmail, Google, etc.

6 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Democratic congressional legislators support or
7 initiate legislation to protect public internet privacy through explicit standards against
8 government location tracking and surveillance of online data.

20 September 10, 2006 meeting in Ellensburg. The resolution will be forwarded to the
21 WSDCC at its next meeting on September 29 - 30, 2006 in Tacoma.

23 The WSDCC passed this resolution at its September 30, 2006 meeting in Tacoma.
