

## Resolution on Speedy Trial

3 **WHEREAS** the U.S. government has imprisoned some U.S. citizens and hundreds  
4 citizens of other nations without access to lawyers and without being charged with a  
5 crime; and

7 **WHEREAS** the U.S. Constitution guarantees that all those imprisoned have the right to  
8 know the charges and evidence being brought against them and the right to a speedy  
9 trial;

11 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Washington State Congressional Delegation  
12 works to repeal and votes against any federal legislation authorizing detention of  
13 national or non-nationals in the U.S. (or anywhere else by U.S. authority) without due  
14 process of law including the right to a speedy trial by a jury of their peers.
