

1 **Resolution in Support of the Democratic National**
2 **Committee's 50-State Strategy**

4 **WHEREAS**, the 2006 midterm election was an overwhelming success for Democrats
5 across the Country, with Democrats regaining control of both the House and Senate in
6 Congress, capturing 6 additional governorships from Republicans, while retaining all
7 14 of their contested governorships, and gaining majorities in seven additional state
8 legislatures; and

10 **WHEREAS**, DNC Chairman Howard Dean delivered on his promise to invest in
11 rebuilding the party in every state in the country, including Red states, and has hired,
12 trained, and deployed seasoned organizers and communications specialists to every
13 state well in advance of the midterm elections, and also delivered on his promise to
14 rebuild Democratic voter files and get-out-the-vote infrastructure, and that these party-
15 building efforts enabled Democrats to take advantage of the wave of public sentiment
16 against Republican rule in Congress even in states and districts that were not originally
17 thought to be competitive; and

19 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Washington State Democratic Central
20 Committee supports the Democratic National Committee's 50-State Strategy, and
21 expresses its appreciation to DNC Chairman Howard Dean for his persistence and
22 leadership in executing this program, and for his ongoing commitment to revitalizing
23 the Democratic Party throughout the entire United States.
