3 **WHEREAS**, the Bush Administration has allowed physical torture and abuse of both
4 citizens and non-citizens in the name of its anti-terrorist efforts;

6 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, we demand that rules of the Geneva
7 Convention regulating the treatment of prisoners governing same, as well as other
8 treaties and U.S. laws, be enforced immediately and totally. Furthermore no U.S.
9 government official, employer, employee or contractor shall be free from prosecutions
10 resulting from the abrogation of such laws and treaties.

12 **THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Washington State Democratic
13 Central Committee urge that the Washington State Congressional delegation and the
14 Democratic National Committee support this resolution.
