

1 **Reform of Federal Vehicle**
2 **Fuel Mileage Requirements**

4 **WHEREAS**, the United States is the biggest user of oil in the world; and

5
6 **WHEREAS**, a major use of oil in the United States is for transportation; and

7
8 **WHEREAS**, there has never been a federal requirement for increased/improved
9 mileage for pick-ups, SUVs and vans, similar to the requirement already in place for
10 passenger cars;

11
12 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, federal requirements be put in place
13 mandating increased fuel efficiency for pick-ups, SUVs and vans, and that these federal
14 requirements take effect by 2015.

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, copies of this resolution are to be sent to our
17 congressional Delegation to begin immediate efforts to obtain passage of such
18 requirements.
