

Resolution to Fund the Latino Vote Project

3 **WHEREAS**, our State Party has done outreach to the Latino community through the
4 Latino Vote Project, implementing a top national priority of the Democratic Party; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Latino Vote Project is currently defunct; and

7
8 **WHEREAS**, in reference to the Latino Vote Project, the State Party website refers to a
9 staff person who is no longer employed; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the State Party must continue outreach to the burgeoning Latino
12 community, which is emerging into a potentially major Democratic voting bloc; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the State Party Chairman has indicated that we have available funds of \$1.2
15 million

16
17 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the budget be amended to reestablish the
18 funding of the Latino Vote Project to at least equal to the 2006-2007 levels.

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED THAT**, the Hispanic/Latino Caucus shall act as an
21 advisory board to the Latino Vote Project.
