Support the Completion of the 1 **Columbia Basin Irrigation Project** 2 3 4 WHEREAS the Columbia Basin Irrigation (CBI) project was started under President 5 Franklin D. Roosevelt's term with the design and engineering being done; 6 7 WHEREAS the Grand Coulee Dam was built and pumps installed to pump water to 8 supply Banks Lake for future irrigation through canals to the CBI project; 9 10 WHEREAS the total CBI project was intended to irrigate approximately 1,029,000 acres, 11 but only 571,000 acres being supplied water to date. The first water being delivered in 12 the early 1950s; 13 14 WHEREAS the total CBI project has created many thousands of jobs, tax dollars, and 15 food for the world; 16 17 WHEREAS the CBI project also created many lakes used for recreational purposes and 18 many, many varieties of wildlife; 19 20 WHEREAS the Bureau of Reclamation in the 2014-2015 is increasing the CBI project 21 another 70,000 acres for irrigation of which a portion of this water will replace the deep 22 wells pumping for the Odessa Aquifer, which has continued declining due to heavy 23 withdrawal from pumping for irrigation, which would leave more water for the towns' 24 and cities' water supply; 25 26 **WHEREAS** the water for the entire project was allotted from the Columbia River when 27 the project first started, and now with new farming techniques and irrigation districts in 28 water conservation, the amount would be less than originally thought; 29 30 WHEREAS the completion of the CBI project would mirror the existing portion of the 31 project; 32 33 **WHEREAS** the CBI project could create many thousands of jobs, increase the property 34 tax base and food products for the world, and increase other businesses related to 35 farming; and 36 WHEREAS it would create additional thousands of acres for wildlife and many newly 37 38 created lakes for recreational purposes; and 39 40 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washington State Democrats support the 41 completion of the CBI project and urge the Governor of the State of Washington, our 42 Democratic State and National Senators and Representatives of Washington State.
