

42 **WHEREAS** Washington State gives away approximately \$30 billion in tax breaks per
43 biennium and has no state capital gains tax on the top 1 percent of earners;

45 **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Washington State Democratic Central
46 Committee requests that our State Officials promptly and fully comply with the
47 Supreme Court's orders in McCleary and pass a new education funding plan that
48 actually and amply funds basic education with progressive taxation, such as closing
49 corporate tax loopholes on the wealthiest corporations and implementing a capital
50 gains tax on the top 1 percent, in order not to increase the burden on the state's lowest
51 income earners or cut other social services or education programs.
