A Resolution in Support of Carbon Net-Zero Electricity in Washington State

WHEREAS fossil-fuel carbon emissions are undesirable pollutants that can be reduced economically; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the WSDCC urge our legislative delegations that state and federal policies should include consideration of all net-zero carbon emission sources for generating electricity; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the WSDCC urges policies which emphasize research and development into the life cycle of each form of energy production to identify more efficient, less polluting, and economically beneficial forms of energy.
