

1 **Resolution to Hold Impeachment Proceedings in the U.S.**
2 **House of Representatives against President Donald J.**
3 **Trump.**
4

5 Whereas: Donald J. Trump, President of the United States has committed high crimes
6 and misdemeanors;

7
8 Whereas: Donald J. Trump, in his conduct of the office of President of the United States,
9 in violation of his constitutional oath faithfully to execute the office of President of the
10 United States and, to the best of his ability, preserve, protect, and defend the
11 Constitution of the United States, and in violation of his constitutional duty to take care
12 that the laws be faithfully executed, has:

- 13 1. Prevented, obstructed, and impeded the administration of justice;
- 14 2. Made false or misleading statements to lawfully authorized investigative officers
15 and employees of the United States;
- 16 3. Withheld relevant and material evidence or information from Congress and lawfully
17 authorized investigative officers and employees of the United States;
- 18 4. Approved, condoned, acquiesced in, and counselled witnesses with respect to the
19 giving of false or misleading statements to lawfully authorized investigative officers
20 and employees of the United States and false or misleading testimony in duly
21 instituted judicial and congressional proceedings;
- 22 5. Interfering or endeavoring to interfere with the conduct of investigations by the
23 Department of Justice of the United States, the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
24 Special Prosecutor, and Congressional Committees;
- 25 6. Approved, condoned, and acquiesced in, the surreptitious payment of substantial
26 sums of money for the purpose of obtaining the silence or influencing the testimony
27 of witnesses, potential witnesses or individuals who participated in such unlawful
28 entry and other illegal activities;
- 29 7. Made or caused to be made false or misleading public statements for the purpose
30 of deceiving the people of the United States into believing that a thorough and
31 complete investigation had been conducted with respect to allegations of
32 misconduct on the part of personnel of the executive branch of the United States
33 and that there was no involvement of such personnel in such misconduct;
- 34 8. Endeavored to cause prospective defendants, and individuals duly tried and
35 convicted, to expect favored treatment and consideration in return for their silence
36 or false testimony, or rewarding individuals for their silence or false testimony;

38 Whereas: Donald J. Trump has acted in a manner contrary to his trust as President and
39 subversive of constitutional government, to the great prejudice of the cause of law and
40 justice and to the manifest injury of the people of the United States;

42 Whereas: Donald J. Trump, by such conduct, warrants impeachment and trial;
